SUBJECT: 2015 INDUSTRY WIDE BUSINESS CONTINUITY TEST

The Securities Industry and Financial Markets Association ("SIFMA") and the Futures Industry Association ("FIA") in coordination with the Financial Information Forum ("FIF") are leading an industry-wide business continuity test that will take place on Saturday, October 24, 2015. Member firms participating in the test must complete basic connectivity testing with OCC prior to the October 24th test. A date has been set aside for pre-testing, Saturday, September 12, 2015.

Please contact your Member Services Representative or email occDRtest@theocc.com if you are interested in testing on Saturday, September 12, 2015 and/or Saturday, October 24, 2015.

The test will include options, futures, equities, fixed income, market data, settlement and payment system components. SIFMA is coordinating the equities and options components, FIA is coordinating the futures component and the FIF is coordinating the market data component.

The format of this exercise will be similar to the 2014 connectivity test. The test will require firms, exchanges and service bureaus to connect simultaneously using backup data centers and alternate operations sites to receive and transmit simulated executions and settlement interactions. The options portion of the test will include the transmission of data between OCC's backup facility and Clearing Members' alternate sites. This will require firms to receive and send (if applicable) test data using each firms' communication protocol (NDM, SFTP, and MQ).

Upon completion of testing, SIFMA and FIA will compile aggregate results but will not reveal the individual performance of any single organization.

This is a critical exercise that will highlight our industry's ability to continue operations in the event of a major disruption. We urge all member firms to participate in this important initiative.

Test Registration
