SUBJECT: TIVO CORPORATION - CASH IN LIEU SETTLEMENT

ADJUSTED OPTION SYMBOL: XPER1 ADJUSTED FUTURES SYMBOL: TIVO2D

TiVo Corporation options and futures were adjusted on June 1, 2020 (See OCC Information Memo #47079). The new deliverable became 1) 45 Xperi Holding Corporation (XPER) Common Shares, and 2) Cash in lieu of 0.5 fractional XPER shares. Only settlement of the cash portion of XPER1 options exercise/assignment activity and TIVO2D futures settlement was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that a price of \$12.16 per whole XPER share will be used to determine the cash in lieu amount. Accordingly, the cash in lieu amount is:

0.5 x \$12.16 = \$6.08 per XPER1 and TIVO2D Contract

Now that the exact cash in lieu amount has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of June 1, 2020 through June 5, 2020, to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

Terms of the XPER1 options and TIVO2D futures are as follows:

New Deliverable Per Contract: 1) 45 Xperi Holding Corporation (XPER) Common Shares

2) \$6.08 Cash

STRIKE PRICES: Unchanged

CUSIP: XPER: 98390M103

MULTIPLIER: 100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

SETTLEMENT

The XPER component of XPER1 exercise/assignment activity and TIVO2D futures settlement from June 1, 2020 through June 4, 2020, has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$6.08 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

PRICING

The underlying price for XPER1 options and TIVO2D futures will be determined as follows:

XPER1 = 0.45 (XPER) + 0.0608

For example, if XPER closes at 13.80, the XPER1 price would be calculated as follows:

XPER1 = 0.45 (13.80) + 0.0608 = 6.27
