Tocagen Inc. (TOCA) has announced a 1-for-15 reverse stock split and a name/symbol/CUSIP change. As a result of the reverse stock split and name/symbol/CUSIP change, each TOCA Common Share will be converted into the right to receive approximately 0.066667 (New) Forte Biosciences, Inc. (FBRX) Common Shares. The reverse stock split and name/symbol/CUSIP change will become effective before the market open on June 16, 2020. Cash will be paid in lieu of fractional FBRX shares.

fractional FBRX Shares is determined. Upon determination of the cash in lieu amount, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees to deliver the appropriate cash amount.
