**Subject:** TCF Financial Corporation - Cash In Lieu Settlement  
Adjusted Option Symbol: HBAN1

TCF Financial Corporation options were adjusted on June 9, 2021 (See OCC Information Memo #48816). The new deliverable became 1) 300 Huntington Bancshares Incorporated (HBAN) Common Shares, and 2) Cash in lieu of 0.28 fractional HBAN shares. Only settlement of the cash portion of HBAN1 options exercise/assignment activity was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that a price of \$14.82 per whole HBAN share will be used to determine the cash in lieu amount. Accordingly, the cash in lieu amount is:

$$0.28 \times \$14.82 = \$4.15 \text{ per HBAN1 Contract}$$

Now that the exact cash in lieu amount has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of June 9, 2021 through June 16, 2021, to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

**The cash in lieu of fractional share portion of the option deliverable remains fixed and does not vary with price changes of any security.**

Terms of the HBAN1 options are as follows:

**New Deliverable**

**Per Contract:** 1) 300 Huntington Bancshares Incorporated (HBAN) Common Shares  
2) \$4.15 Cash

**Strike Prices:** Unchanged

**CUSIP:** HBAN: 446150104

**Multiplier:** 100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

**Settlement**

The HBAN component of HBAN1 exercise/assignment activity from June 9, 2021 through June 15, 2021, has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$4.15 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

**Pricing**

The underlying price for HBAN1 will be determined as follows:

$$\text{HBAN1} = 3.00 (\text{HBAN}) + 0.0415$$

For example, if HBAN closes at 14.46, the HBAN1 price would be calculated as follows:

$$\text{HBAN1} = 3.00 (14.46) + 0.0415 = 43.42$$
