Frank's International N.V. (FI) has announced an anticipated 1-for-6 reverse stock split and a name, symbol, and CUSIP change in conjunction with the merger with Expro Group Holdings N.V. As a result of the reverse stock split and underlying changes, each FI Common Share will be converted into the right to receive approximately 0.166667 (New) Expro Group Holdings N.V. (XPRO) Ordinary Shares. The reverse stock split and underlying changes are anticipated to become effective before the market open on October 4, 2021. Cash will be paid in lieu of fractional XPRO shares.

Delayed Settlement

The XPRO component of the XPRO1 deliverable will settle through National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC). OCC will delay settlement of the cash portion of the XPRO1 deliverable until the cash in lieu of fractional XPRO Shares is determined. Upon determination of the cash in lieu amount, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees to deliver the appropriate cash amount.
