Subject: Adjusted NeuroBo Pharmaceuticals, Inc. – Cash In Lieu Settlement Adjusted Option Symbol: NRBO1

Adjusted NeuroBo Pharmaceuticals, Inc. options were adjusted on September 13, 2022 (See OCC Information Memo #51010).

The new deliverable became 1) 3 NeuroBo Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (NRBO) Common Shares, 2) Cash in lieu of approximately 0.3333 fractional NRBO Shares. Only settlement of the cash portion of NRBO1 options exercise/assignment activity was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that a price of \$13.53 per whole NRBO share will be used to determine the cash in lieu amount at a rate of 0.3333. Accordingly, the cash in lieu amount is:

0.3333 x \$13.53 = \$4.51 per NRBO1 Contract

Now that the exact cash in lieu amount has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of September 13, 2022 through September 22, 2022, to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

The cash in lieu of fractional share portion of the option deliverable remains fixed and does not vary with price changes of any security.

Terms of the NRBO1 options are as follows:

New Deliverable Per Contract:	1) 3 NeuroBo Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (NRBO) Common Shares 2) \$4.51 Cash
Strike Prices:	Unchanged
CUSIP:	64132R206
Multiplier:	100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

<u>Settlement</u>

The NRBO component of NRBO1 exercise/assignment activity from September 13, 2022 through September 21, 2022, has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$4.51 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

Pricing

The underlying price for NRBO1 will be determined as follows:

NRBO1 = 0.03 (NRBO) + 0.0451

For example, if NRBO closes at 15.67, the NRBO1 price would be calculated as follows:

NRBO1 = 0.03 (15.67) + 0.0451 = 0.52
