**Subject:** OCC Clearing Member Cyber Attestation Program - Reminder

On June 27, 2022, OCC published memo #50648 regarding implementation of a Clearing Member Cybersecurity Attestation Program, which is an information security risk management program designed to gain assurance that Clearing Members are utilizing an industry-accepted cybersecurity framework to govern their cybersecurity risk management program. It leverages current regulatory or standards-setting body frameworks and does not set any new control standards. This program is the same program adopted by The Depository Trust and Clearing Corporation. Rule 219 of the OCC Rules outlines the requirements of the program.

**As a result, Clearing Members must provide contact information of a designated control officer who is responsible for their firm's cybersecurity program by January 13, 2023.** OCC previously sent a Cyber Attestation Form to operations managers at each firm which must be completed, signed by the control officer and returned to OCC. Clearing Members who do not return this form by January 13, 2023, will be subject to a rule violation.
