Global X Emerging Markets Internet & E-commerce ETF (EWEB) has announced a 1-for-3 reverse stock split. As a result of the reverse stock split, each EWEB share will be converted into the right to receive approximately 0.333333 (New) Global X Emerging Markets Internet & E-commerce ETF shares. The reverse stock split will become effective before the market open on December 20, 2022. Cash will be paid in lieu of fractional shares.

Pricing

Until the cash in lieu amount is determined, the underlying price for EWEB1 will be determined as follows:

EWEB1 = 0.333333 (EWEB)

Delayed Settlement

The EWEB component of the EWEB1 deliverable will settle through National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC). OCC will delay settlement of the cash portion of the EWEB1 deliverable until the cash in lieu of fractional EWEB Shares is determined. Upon determination of the cash in lieu amount, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees to deliver the appropriate cash amount.
