**Subject:** Adjusted Global X SuperDividend ETF - Cash In Lieu Settlement  
Adjusted Option Symbol: SDIV1

Adjusted Global X SuperDividend ETF options were adjusted on December 20, 2022 (See OCC Information Memo #51485). The new deliverable became 1) 33 Global X SuperDividend ETF (SDIV) Shares, and 2) Cash in lieu of approximately 0.3333 fractional SDIV shares. Only settlement of the cash portion of SDIV1 options exercise/assignment activity was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that a price of \$23.98 per whole SDIV share will be used to determine the cash in lieu amount at a rate of 0.3333. Accordingly, the cash in lieu amount is:

$$0.3333 \times \$23.98 = \$7.99 \text{ per SDIV1 Contract}$$

Now that the exact cash in lieu amount has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of December 20, 2022 through January 12, 2023, to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

**The cash in lieu of fractional share portion of the option deliverable remains fixed and does not vary with price changes of any security.**

Terms of the SDIV1 options are as follows:

**New Deliverable**

**Per Contract:** 1) 33 Global X SuperDividend ETF (SDIV) Shares  
2) \$7.99 Cash

**Strike Prices:** Unchanged

**CUSIP:** SDIV: 37960A669

**Multiplier:** 100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

**Settlement**

The SDIV component of SDIV1 exercise/assignment activity from December 20, 2022 through January 11, 2023, has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$7.99 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

**Pricing**

The underlying price for SDIV1 will be determined as follows:

$$\text{SDIV1} = 0.33 (\text{SDIV}) + 0.0799$$

For example, if SDIV closes at 25.50, the SDIV1 price would be calculated as follows:

$$\text{SDIV1} = 0.33 (25.50) + 0.0799 = 8.49$$
