 VanEck Digital Assets Mining ETF – Liquidation/Cash Settlement/Acceleration of Expirations Option Symbol: DAM Date: 05/02/2023

On April 13, 2023, VanEck ETF Trust announced it will close and subsequently liquidate the VanEck Digital Assets Mining ETF (DAM). DAM shares stopped trading on NASDAQ after market close on April 24, 2023. Proceeds of the liquidations were distributed to shareholders in the amount of \$11.47495 cash per DAM share on May 2, 2023.

Contract Adjustment

The option symbol DAM will not change.

DAM options, which were subject to delayed settlement from April 25, 2023 through May 1, 2023, are no longer subject to delayed settlement, effective May 2, 2023.

Settlement in DAM options will take place through OCC's cash settlement system. Settlement will be accomplished by payment of the difference between the extended strike amount and the cash deliverable.

Acceleration of Expirations

Pursuant to OCC Rule 807, equity stock option contracts whose deliverables are adjusted to call for cashonly delivery will be subject to an acceleration of the expiration dates for outstanding option series. (See OCC Information Memo 23707) Additionally, the exercise by exception (ex by ex) threshold for expiring series will be \$.01 in all account types.

All series of VanEck Digital Assets Mining ETF options whose expiration dates are after 05-19-2023 will have their expiration dates advanced to 05-19-2023. Expiration dates occurring before 05-19-2023 (e.g., Flex options) will remain unchanged.

All VanEck Digital Assets Mining ETF options will utilize a \$.01 exercise threshold.

Option Symbol: DAM Existing Expiration: All months New expiration date: 05-19-2023

Existing American-style VanEck Digital Assets Mining ETF options remain exercisable at the option of the holder prior to their expiration. Exercised options will continue to settle in two business days.
