On November 8, 2023, Listed Fund Trust announced it will liquidate the B.A.D. ETF (BAD). BAD shares were suspended from trading on the New York Stock Exchange before the open on November 28, 2023. **Proceeds of the liquidation were distributed to shareholders in the amount of \$11.90991101 per BAD share on November 29, 2023.**

Contract Adjustment

The option symbol BAD will not change.

New Deliverable
Per Contract: \$1,190.99 Cash (\$11.90991101 x 100)

BAD options, which were subject to delayed settlement on November 28, 2023, are no longer subject to delayed settlement, effective November 29, 2023.

Settlement in BAD options will take place through OCC's cash settlement system. Settlement will be accomplished by payment of the difference between the extended strike amount and the cash deliverable.

Acceleration of Expirations

Pursuant to OCC Rule 807, equity stock option contracts whose deliverables are adjusted to call for cash-only delivery will be subject to an acceleration of the expiration dates for outstanding option series. (See OCC Information Memo 23707) Additionally, the exercise by exception (ex by ex) threshold for expiring series will be \$.01 in all account types.

All series of B.A.D. ETF options whose expiration dates are after 12-15-2023 will have their expiration dates advanced to 12-15-2023. Expiration dates occurring before 12-15-2023 (e.g., Flex options) will remain unchanged.

All B.A.D. ETF options will utilize a \$.01 exercise threshold.

Option Symbol: BAD

Existing Expiration: All months
New expiration date: 12-15-2023

Existing American-style B.A.D. ETF options remain exercisable at the option of the holder prior to their expiration. Exercised options will continue to settle in two business days.
