On March 27, 2024, Shareholders of Callon Petroleum Company (CPE) will vote concerning the proposed merger with APA Corporation (APA). If the merger is approved and consummated, each existing CPE Common Share will be converted into the right to receive 1.0425 APA Common Shares. Cash will be paid in lieu of fractional APA shares.
