Subject: Luther Burbank Corporation - Cash In Lieu Settlement

Adjusted Option Symbol: WAFD1

Luther Burbank Corporation options were adjusted on March 1, 2024 (See OCC Information Memo #54222). The new deliverable became 1) 33 Washington Federal, Inc. (WAFD) Common Shares, and 2) Cash in lieu of 0.53 fractional WAFD shares. Only settlement of the cash portion of WAFD1 options exercise/assignment activity was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that a price of \$28.71 per whole WAFD share will be used to determine the cash in lieu amount. Accordingly, the cash in lieu amount is:

0.53 x \$28.71 = \$15.22 per WAFD1 Contract

Now that the exact cash in lieu amount has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of March 1, 2024 through March 13, 2024, to deliver the appropriate cash amount

The cash in lieu of fractional share portion of the option deliverable remains fixed and does not vary with price changes of any security.

Terms of the WAFD1 options are as follows:

**New Deliverable** 

**Per Contract:** 1) 33 Washington Federal, Inc. (WAFD) Common Shares

2) \$15.22 Cash

Strike Prices: Unchanged

**CUSIP:** WAFD: 938824109

Multiplier: 100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

<u>Settlement</u>

The WAFD component of WAFD1 exercise/assignment activity from March 1, 2024 through March 12, 2024, has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$15.22 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

## **Pricing**

The underlying price for WAFD1 will be determined as follows:

WAFD1 = 0.33 (WAFD) + 0.1522

For example, if WAFD closes at 27.54, the WAFD1 price would be calculated as follows:

WAFD1 = 
$$0.33(27.54) + 0.1522 = 9.24$$
