Subject: CapStar Financial Holdings, Inc. - Cash In Lieu Settlement Adjusted Option Symbol: ONB1

CapStar Financial Holdings, Inc. options were adjusted on April 1, 2024 (See OCC Information Memo #54403). The new deliverable became 1) 115 Old National Bancorp (ONB) Common Shares, and 2) Cash in lieu of 0.5 fractional ONB Common Shares. Only settlement of the cash portion of ONB1 options exercise/assignment activity was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that a price of \$17.0720 per whole ONB share will be used to determine the cash in lieu amount. Accordingly, the cash in lieu amount is:

0.5 x \$17.0720 = \$8.54 per ONB1 Contract

Now that the exact cash in lieu amount has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of April 1, 2024 through April 16, 2024, to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

The cash in lieu of fractional share portion of the option deliverable remains fixed and does not vary with price changes of any security.

Terms of the ONB1 options are as follows:

New Deliverable Per Contract:	1) 115 Old National Bancorp (ONB) Common Shares 2) \$8.54 Cash
Strike Prices:	Unchanged
CUSIP:	ONB: 680033107
Multiplier:	100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

<u>Settlement</u>

The ONB component of ONB1 exercise/assignment activity from April 1, 2024 through April 15, 2024, has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$8.54 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

Pricing

The underlying price for ONB1 will be determined as follows:

ONB1 = 1.15 (ONB) + 0.0854

For example, if ONB closes at 15.69, the ONB1 price would be calculated as follows:

ONB1 = 1.15 (15.69) + 0.0854 = 18.13
