Subject: Adjusted Fomento Economico Mexicano, S.A.B. de C.V. – Cash Distribution Settlement Adjusted Option Symbol: FMX3

Adjusted Fomento Economico Mexicano, S.A.B. de C.V. options were adjusted on October 16, 2024, on January 17, 2025, and on April 24, 2025 (See OCC Information Memos #55434, #55972, and #56382). The new deliverable became 1) 100 Fomento Economico Mexicano, S.A.B. de C.V. (FMX) American Depositary Shares and 2) Approximately \$193.95 Cash (\$68.34 + (approximately \$1.256089 x 100)). Only settlement of the cash component of FMX3 options exercise/assignment activity was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that the final cash distribution rate is \$1.13048 (\$1.256089 gross dividend less \$0.125608 withholding tax) per FMX share held.

Now that the final cash distribution rate has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of April 24, 2025 through May 06, 2025, to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

Terms of the FMX3 options are as follows:

New Deliverable Per Contract:	1) 100 Fomento Economico Mexicano, S.A.B. de C.V. (FMX) American Depositary Shares 2) \$181.39 Cash (\$68.34 + (\$1.13048 x 100))
Strike Prices:	Unchanged
CUSIP:	FMX: 344419106
Multiplier:	100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

Settlement

The FMX component of FMX3 exercise/assignment activity from April 24, 2025 through May 5, 2025 has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$181.39 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

Pricing

The underlying price for FMX3 options will be determined as follows:

FMX3 = FMX + 1.8139

For example, if FMX closes at 100.73, the FMX3 price would be calculated as follows:

FMX3 = 100.73 + 1.8139 = 102.54
