The FMX component of the FMX5 deliverable will settle through National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC). OCC will delay settlement of the cash portion of the FMX5 deliverable until the exact cash amount is determined. Upon determination of the exact cash amount, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees to deliver the appropriate cash amount.
