Subject: Adjusted SOLAI Limited – Cash In Lieu Settlement
Adjusted Option Symbol: SLAI1

Adjusted SOLAI Limited options were adjusted on July 6, 2026 (See OCC Information Memo #59272). The new deliverable became 1) 14 SOLAI Limited (SLAIY) American Depositary Shares and 2) Cash in lieu of approximately 0.2857 fractional SLAIY Shares. Only settlement of the cash portion of SLAI1 options exercise/assignment activity was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that a price of \$3.0764 per whole SLAIY share will be used to determine the cash in lieu amount at a rate of 0.2857. Accordingly, the cash in lieu amount is:

$$0.2857 \times \$3.0764 = \$0.88 \text{ per SLAI1 Contract}$$

Now that the exact cash in lieu amount has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of July 6, 2026 through July 24, 2026, to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

The cash in lieu of fractional share portion of the option deliverable remains fixed and does not vary with price changes of any security.

Terms of the SLAI1 options are as follows:

New Deliverable

Per Contract: 1) 14 SOLAI Limited (SLAIY) American Depositary Shares
2) \$0.88 Cash

Strike Prices: Unchanged

CUSIP: SLAIY: 055474308

Multiplier: 100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

Settlement

The SLAIY component of SLAI1 exercise/assignment activity from July 6, 2026 through July 23, 2026, has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$0.88 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

Pricing

The underlying price for SLAI1 will be determined as follows:

$$\text{SLAI1} = 0.14 (\text{SLAIY}) + 0.0088$$

For example, if SLAIY closes at 0.5611, the SLAI1 price would be calculated as follows:

$$\text{SLAI1} = 0.14 (0.5611) + 0.0088 = 0.09$$
