Subject: Adjusted American Bitcoin Corporation – Cash In Lieu Settlement
Adjusted Option Symbol: ABTC1

Adjusted American Bitcoin Corporation options were adjusted on July 6, 2026 (See OCC Information Memo #59285). The new deliverable became 1) 6 American Bitcoin Corporation (ABTC) Class A Common Shares and 2) Cash in lieu of approximately 0.6667 fractional ABTC Shares. Only settlement of the cash portion of ABTC1 options exercise/assignment activity was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that a price of \$5.26118 per whole ABTC share will be used to determine the cash in lieu amount at a rate of 0.6667. Accordingly, the cash in lieu amount is:

$$0.6667 \times \$5.26118 = \$3.51 \text{ per ABTC1 Contract}$$

Now that the exact cash in lieu amount has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of July 6, 2026 through July 27, 2026, to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

The cash in lieu of fractional share portion of the option deliverable remains fixed and does not vary with price changes of any security.

Terms of the ABTC1 options are as follows:

New Deliverable

Per Contract: 1) 6 American Bitcoin Corporation (ABTC) Class A Common Shares
2) \$3.51 Cash

Strike Prices: Unchanged

CUSIP: ABTC: 02462A203

Multiplier: 100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

Settlement

The ABTC component of ABTC1 exercise/assignment activity from July 6, 2026 through July 24, 2026, has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$3.51 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

Pricing

The underlying price for ABTC1 will be determined as follows:

$$\text{ABTC1} = 0.06 (\text{ABTC}) + 0.0351$$

For example, if ABTC closes at 5.72, the ABTC1 price would be calculated as follows:

$$\text{ABTC1} = 0.06 (5.72) + 0.0351 = 0.38$$
